

## TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

John Chapter 12

Context: Setting the Table

The first four chapters of John's Gospel introduce the witnesses to Jesus, describe his first two signs, and depict a variety of initial responses to the launch of his ministry. Chapters five through eleven record the next four signs, together with the increasing hostility that Jesus faced, particularly from the Jerusalem leadership. This twelfth chapter concludes and summarizes the public ministry of Jesus—the hour for the Son of Man to be glorified had arrived.

#### Content: Hearing the Text

Read John 12 together out loud.

#### Credo: Believing the Truth

The followers of Jesus were convinced he was the Messiah. Mary anointed him, the crowds acclaimed him, and even the Gentiles wanted to meet him. Yet Jesus was not interested in the plans of his disciples but in the will of his Father. His hour—the hour of his cup, his cross, his tomb, his resurrection—had come. Though Jesus would indeed be "high and lifted up," it would be in a manner far different than anyone had ever expected. His throne a cross, his attendants thieves, he would single-handedly cast out the prince of this world, breaking the power of sin and death, receiving the glory of his Father, and achieving victory for all who would believe on him.

#### Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Discuss the meaning of the text and then walk through the following application questions as you discuss the difference this meaning ought to make in our lives today.

The "spirituality" of Judas's words hid the ulterior motives of his heart. How might we, even in the smallest of ways, be guilty of the same hypocrisy?

*EXAMPLES*: Using spiritual sounding language to one-up others, using "prayer requests" as an excuse to gossip, etc.

What are some of the ways in which we, like the rulers who "believed" in Jesus, can love the praise of men more than the praise of God?

*EXAMPLES*: Doing "devotions" in order to impress others, compromising our Christian testimony in order to avoid mockery etc.




## Book of the Month
