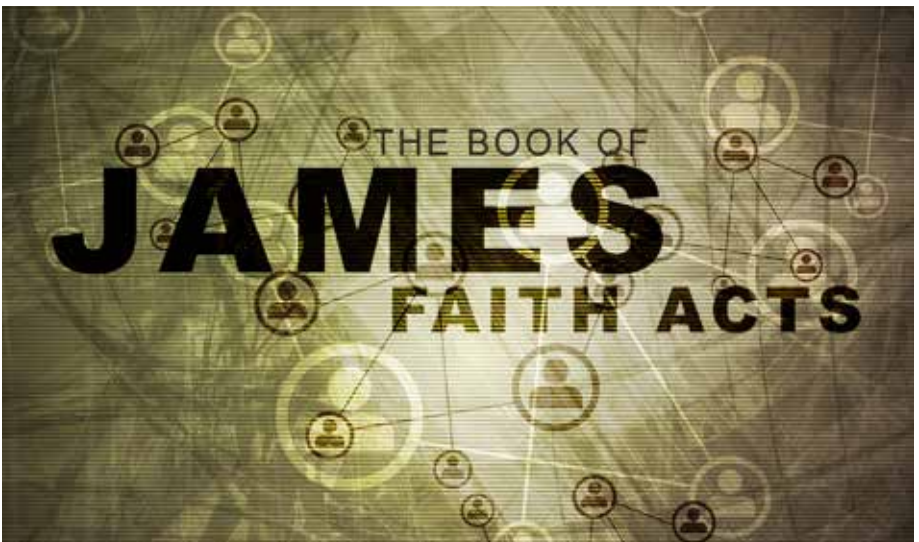

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

John Chapter 14

Context: Setting the Table

After introducing the witnesses to Jesus in chapter one, John recorded the public ministry of Jesus in chapters two through eleven, focusing in particular on his first six signs, each of which called for belief. Chapter twelve summarizes Christ's public ministry and marks the coming of his long-awaited "hour." This fourteenth chapter continues Jesus's farewell discourse from the previous chapter, as he prepares his disciples for the coming trauma of the crucifixion.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read John 14 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Jesus was going away and his disciples were troubled. Although they could not yet fully understand all that he was saying to them, Jesus poured into his struggling disciples the truths they would need to make it through the difficult days ahead. Jesus would not leave his disciples, then or now, comfortless. He would reveal himself to them after his resurrection, he would be present with them through the Spirit after his ascension, and he would finally come again to them, to receive them unto himself, forever to live in the love of the Father's house. These truths are the permanent comfort of all those who love him.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Discuss the meaning of the text and then walk through the following application questions as you discuss the difference this meaning ought to make in our lives today.

Jesus is the only way to the Father, the only hope that anyone anywhere has of escaping the just wrath of God. How can we better live out the urgency of this truth in our day to day lives?

When we pray "in Jesus's name" we are making a claim to be "his representatives who are about his business." What are some ways we can remind ourselves to take this reality with the seriousness it deserves?

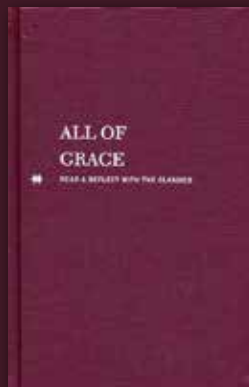
