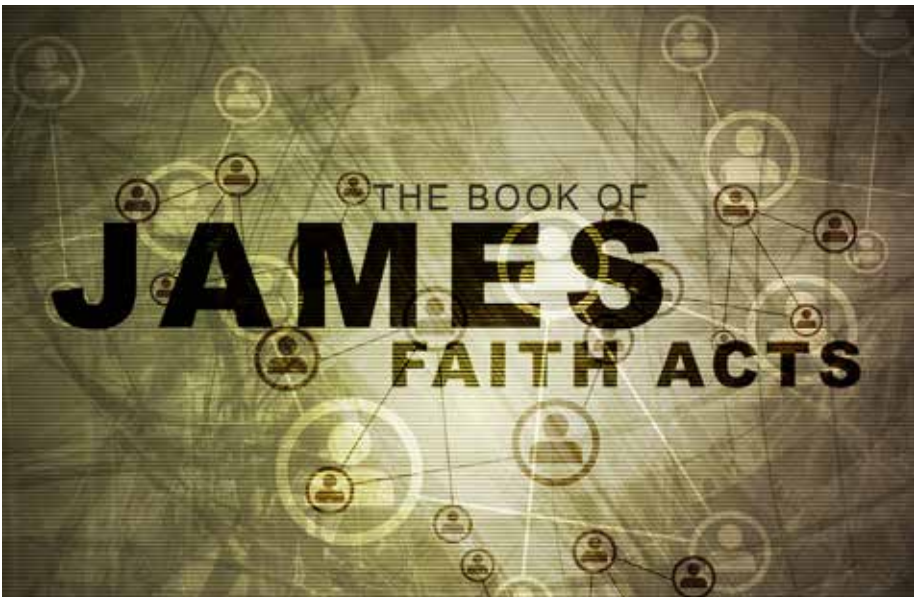

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

John Chapter 18

Context: Setting the Table

In his first twelve chapters, John introduced the witnesses to Jesus and described his public ministry, including his first six signs and the increasing opposition these signs led to. Chapters thirteen through seventeen record Jesus's preparation of his disciples for his soon coming departure. This eighteenth chapter begins John's account of the death-and-resurrection of Jesus, the seventh and final sign.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read John 18 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Jesus knew what was about to happen. He knew the cup he was about to drink was deep and bitter. Yet he stepped boldly forth, defending to the very end those whom the Father had given him. No one took his life from him—he chose to lay it down, chose to submit to the plan of the Father, chose to endure the shameful series of sham trials this chapter records. Peter, so eager to defend Jesus that he refused to listen to him, ended up denying him altogether. Jesus, in the face of scandalous injustice and undeserved abuse, remained utterly faithful to the purposes of his Father. His faithfulness on our behalf remains the only foundation of our hope.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Discuss the meaning of the text and then walk through the following application questions as you discuss the difference this meaning ought to make in our lives today.

Beginning with a zeal that wouldn't listen to Jesus's instruction, Peter finished by denying him altogether. In both cases, the fundamental problem was a refusal to trust the Father's plan when it no longer seemed to make sense. What situations have you faced in your own life in which the Father's plan seemed foolish or impossible?

How might we be tempted to fight for God's kingdom with the methods of this world?

Examples: Replacing the simple proclamation of gospel truth with manipulative salesmanship; engaging in destructive verbal attacks on those we see as our enemies.

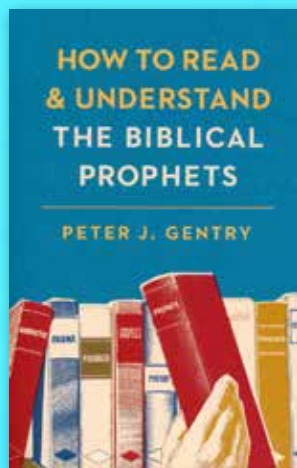
