TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 22:20–23:20

Context: Setting the Table

After its initial creational prologue, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In the twelfth installment of the story of Abraham, he receives word of the birth of his nephews; in the thirteenth, Abraham obtains a burial plot in the land of Canaan for Sarah after she dies.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 22:20–23:20 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Abraham's life was coming to its close. God had appeared to him for the last time. His final test was now a distant, though undoubtedly still vivid, memory. Yet when Sarah died, Abraham did far more than simply find an appropriate resting place. With skill and determination, he negotiated perpetual land rights to a cemetery in Canaan, demonstrating his faith in God's promise that this land he had sojourned in for so long would one day belong to his offspring.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Discuss the meaning of the text and then walk through the following application questions as you discuss the difference this meaning ought to make in our lives today.

Abraham, who left everything to follow God, waited all his life for just one son—yet his brother Nahor, who stayed at home, had twelve sons with no apparent difficulty. How might the apparent ease of others' lives tempt us to jealousy?

Examples: Your unbelieving coworker receives the promotion you feel you deserve; Someone else's home business prospers while yours seems to be on continual life support, etc.

Despite his sometimes shameful mistreatment of her while she was still alive, Abraham's sorrow over the death of his wife made it clear how much he loved her. What are some of the ways in which we could work to show those still living the love that all too often is only made obvious after their death?

Examples: Speaking of our spouses with respect even when they frustrate us; Showing gratitude to our parents, even when they are being difficult, etc.

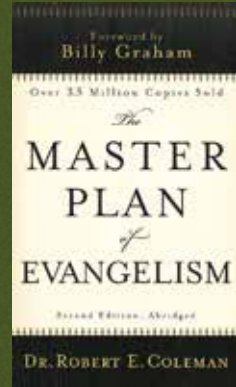
