# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## 26:1–26:33

### *Context: Setting the Table*

After laying a creational foundation, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. Stepping back from the ongoing story of Jacob, this section offers the only focused treatment of Isaac as a character in his own right.

### *Content: Hearing the Text*

Read Genesis 26:1–26:33 together out loud.

### *Credo: Believing the Truth*

After introducing the conflict between Jacob and Esau, the narrative of their struggles pauses to provide a focused review of God's work in the life of their father Isaac. Although Isaac's life receives far less attention than that of either Abraham or Jacob, he too came to learn by experience that God could be trusted to fulfill his promises of presence and blessing—no matter what. Isaac's weakness and personal failure would not and could not derail God's plan to rescue the world through the offspring of Abraham.

### *Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk*

Although God promised to bless Isaac for the sake of Abraham, Isaac still had to learn by experience what it meant to follow God and to receive his blessing. How might we be tempted to forget that the same is true for us?

*Examples:* Young people who try to live off of their parents' walk of faith; Assuming that knowledge alone can substitute for the experience that only comes from following God through the everyday difficulties of life etc.

Despite God's promise of protection and blessing, Isaac chose to follow the example of his father by lying about the identity of his wife. What are some of the ways in which we might be tempted either to choose to follow a bad example or to carelessly set a bad example for future generations?

*Examples:* Allowing the weaknesses we observed in our parents to become an excuse to needlessly fall into the same patterns of failure; Shortsightedly ignoring the multi-generational consequences of the self-protecting shortcuts we are constantly tempted to take etc.

## **MISSIONARIES**

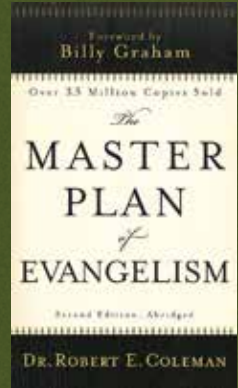
