TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 32:3–32:33

Context: Setting the Table

Following its magnificent introduction, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this section, Jacob is prepared by God to meet Esau and his band of 400 men.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 32:3–32:33 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Delivered from Laban, Jacob was soon to be confronted with Esau. No longer the selfish and deceptive trickster he once was, Jacob could now see the destructive consequences of his past behavior with full force—and it terrified him. In desperation, Jacob, for the first time recorded in Scripture, turned to God in prayer. Finally acknowledging his own “littleness,” he reminded God of his promises and pleaded with him for deliverance. After fighting with Jacob all night, God gave him a new name and a new limp—permanent reminders of the way in which God’s grace breaks us in order to remake us.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

In order to experience the greatness of God’s grace, Jacob had to be willing to abandon his quest for prominence and acknowledge his own “littleness.” What are some of the ways in which our pride keeps us from experiencing the full riches of God’s mercy?

Examples: Attempting to “come out ahead” of those we see as inferior to us; Becoming discontented because our lives have not worked out as we once hoped that they would, etc.

Before he could receive his new name, Jacob had to confront the failures associated with his old one. How might our unwillingness to admit our past failures prevent us from receiving God’s blessings in the present?

Examples: Refusing to pursue genuine repentance in relationships we have harmed by our selfish decisions; Using our victories in some areas to justify our failures in others, etc.

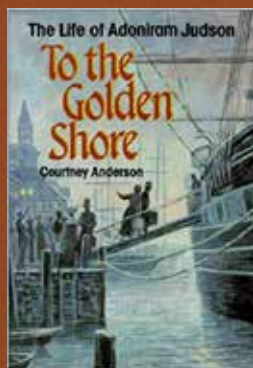
