



TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 38:1–30

Context: Setting the Table

After a stunning creational prologue, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. This section relates the story of Judah, just as the next several sections will relate the story of Joseph.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 38:1–30 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

The actions of Judah, Er, Onan, and Tamar are so twisted and perverse that many believers would prefer to forget that they are even recorded in the Scriptures. Yet though these individuals fully experienced the consequences of the sinful choices that they freely made, their sins, no matter how dark, could not thwart the redemptive purposes of God. No matter how silent God may have seemed to be at the time, he was in reality weaving the threads that would ultimately bring about the birth of the very Word who had spoken the worlds into existence.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Though God initially seems to be completely absent from this dark and dismal story, Judah and Tamar's son Pharez would ultimately turn out to be the ancestor of our Savior. In other words, when it seemed like God was doing nothing at all, he was at work on the greatest of all wonders. What are some of the situations in our own lives in which we might falsely assume that God is "doing nothing?"

Examples: Sickness; financial difficulty; wayward children; marriage difficulties; etc.

Despite Judah's own failings, he was quick to harshly judge the perceived sin of Tamar. How might we be tempted to make ourselves look better than we are by our "zeal" against the sins of others?

Examples: Harshly punishing our children for small infractions when we are in front of others so that we seem to be strict disciplinarians; loudly condemning others for sins of which we ourselves are secretly guilty, etc.


