# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## Genesis 36:1–37:1

### *Context: Setting the Table*

In this section, the story of Esau is brought to a conclusion with a collection of genealogical lists. (For full context, see the leaders notes)

### *Content: Hearing the Text*

Read Genesis 36:1–37:1 together out loud.

### *Credo: Believing the Truth*

Although Esau was the firstborn, God chose Jacob to be the one through whom his gracious promises to Abraham would be fulfilled. Like the earlier genealogy of Ishmael, this section brings the story of Esau to a conclusion before resuming the narrative of the fulfillment of God's redemptive purposes that is the central theme of both the book of Genesis and the Scriptures as a whole.

### *Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk*

Though the sons of Esau were born in the land of promise and the sons of Jacob were born almost entirely outside of it, it would nevertheless be the descendants of Jacob who would inherit the land promised to Abraham. What are some of the ways in which we might falsely assume that the circumstances of our birth or upbringing pose an obstacle to God's free and sovereign grace?

*Examples:* Assuming that the failures of our parents will necessarily limit the ways in which God will choose to use us; Presuming that the privileges of our upbringing render us necessary to the purposes of God, etc.

Chapters 34–35 related the increasing conflict between Jacob's sons, leaving the reader expectantly wondering what will happen next. Yet before we can get to the next installment in this exciting tale, we must first wade through a rather lengthy collection of genealogies. How might our boredom with the less-than-exciting bits of God's plan for our own lives cause us to miss the "next chapter" that is just around the corner?

*Examples:* Skipping over everyday faithfulness in order to get to the "next big thing"; concluding that the dullness of our present circumstances means that we must be "out of the will of God," etc.
