

### TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 37:2-36

#### Context: Setting the Table

Following the initial story of creation, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this section, the division that had long been present in Jacob's family bears bitter fruit in the entrapment and enslavement of Joseph.

#### Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 37:2–36 together out loud.

#### Credo: Believing the Truth

Jacob, who should have known better, selfishly and shamelessly favored Rachel's son over all his other children. Joseph's brothers gave themselves over to hatred and jealousy until they were so embittered against him that they could no longer speak a single peaceable word to him. While evaluations of Joseph's moral character differ (see the notes), his words and actions, whatever their motivation, only made things worse. Yet no matter how often or how deeply God's people failed him, and no matter how much they suffered as a result, neither weakness nor wickedness could thwart the purposes of the God who has the power to bring good out of evil.

#### Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Though Jacob knew from experience the division that selfcentered favoritism can cause, he nevertheless followed the bad example his father Isaac had left him. In what areas of our life might we be tempted to default to the bad examples of others even though we "know better?"

*Examples*: In marriage; in parenting; in relationships; in financial decisions, etc.

The violence of Joseph's brothers, though intended to make his exaltation impossible, was in reality the means that God had appointed to bring it about. How have you seen God's sovereign power bring good out of evil in your own life?

*Examples*: Opposition you encountered because you followed Jesus; devastating and inexplicable suffering and loss, etc.


