



TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 31

Observation (31:39):

In the Ancient Near East, hired shepherds were generally not responsible for the depredations of wild animals—something that both the later code at Sinai (Exodus 22:12) and the earlier Code of Hammurabi make explicit. The demands that Laban made of Jacob were as extraordinary as they were unjust.

Application (31:32):

In his anger at Laban's many false accusations, Jacob allowed himself to be goaded into inadvertently pronouncing the death penalty on Rachel. How might our frustrations at the follies of others tempt us into making foolish and unwise commitments of our own?

Genesis 32

Observation (32:24):

Though described here as a "man," Jacob later considers himself to have come face to face with God (verse 30). In the retelling of this story in Hosea 12:4, Jacob is said to have wrestled with an "angel." As in other passages in Genesis, the persistent ambiguity regarding the relationship between the "man," the "angel" and "God" is fully deliberate and is intended to "express the difficulty of human comprehension of the divine world." [fn: Wenham 1994, 51]

Application (32:9–12):

Jacob's powerful prayer reminded God of the promises he had already given. What are some of the ways in which we can strive to shape our own prayers around the promises God has given to us in the Scriptures?

Matthew 11

Observation (11:1):

Matthew's Gospel groups Jesus's teaching into five distinct blocks, paralleling the five books of Moses. Though English wording varies, the conclusion of each of these blocks is marked in Greek by the presence of an identical phrase, found in the New Testament only in these five places (Matthew 7:28, 11:1, 13:53, 19:1, 26:1).

Application (11:2–6):

When John the Baptist struggled with doubt and discouragement, Jesus encouraged him by reminding him once again of what the Scriptures had to say (Isaiah 35:5–6 and 61:1 among other passages). When we ourselves go through seasons of struggle, how might we be tempted to overlook the Scriptures in our search for encouragement?
