# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## Genesis 44

*Observation (44:16–34):*

In Hebrew narrative, the amount of space given to the speech of an individual is almost always significant. It is therefore very important to note that this is the single longest speech in the entire book.

*Application (44:16–34):*

The humble self-sacrificing plea for Benjamin we find here is a far cry from the repulsive character Judah displayed in chapter 38. Judah, in other words, has been completely transformed. How might we be tempted to believe that genuine heart change is impossible?

## Genesis 45

*Observation (45:6):*

“Earing” is an archaic word that means “to plough.”

*Application (45:5–8):*

When the end of the story became known, even the murderous jealousy of Joseph’s brothers was used by God for good. What are some situations in our own lives from which we are tempted to believe not even God can bring good?

## Matthew 15

*Observation (15:2):*

The purpose of this custom “of washing the hands with water was not primarily hygienic [but rather] the removal of ceremonial defilement and ritual impurity.” (Davies & Allison 1991, 2.521).

*Application (15:2):*

Though the Old Testament itself said nothing about it, this was one of many traditions the Pharisees had devised as a “fence” to “protect” God’s law. Sadly, they ended up being much more passionate about their own fences than they were about the law they were invented to protect. How might we be tempted to be more passionate about our own traditions than about the truth of God they were originally invented to “protect?”
