

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

NUMBERS 8-10

Observation (10:7):

When the congregation of the Lord is gathered together at his return, it will be at the sound of a trumpet (Matthew 24:31; 1 Corinthians 15:51; 1 Thessalonians 4:16).

Observation (10:14-28):

While Levi was not counted as one of the tribes, Ephraim and Manasseh, the sons of Joseph, were counted separately, thus retaining the original number of 12 tribes.

Application (8:14-15, 21-22):

It was only *after* the Levites had thoroughly purified and sanctified themselves that they were allowed to in any way assist with the service of the tabernacle. Despite clear biblical teaching to the contrary, contemporary Christianity all too often treats holiness as optional in its search for charisma and talent. How might we be tempted to do the same?

Examples: Justifying sin in our lives because of the ways in which we think God is “using” us; Treating the ministries God has allowed each of us to participate in as trivial matters that do not require preparation of the heart, etc.

MARK 12:1-17

Observation (12:6):

The word the KJV translates here as “well beloved” is the very same word that is translated as “beloved” in Mark 1:11 and 9:7—the only other two times that this word occurs in his gospel. This serves to underscore the identification of the beloved son in the parable with the One to whom God had already twice claimed from heaven as His beloved Son.

Application (12:17):

While currency bears the images chosen by those who issue it, humanity bears the image of the God who created it (Genesis 1:27), the image to which those who belong to Jesus are even now being re-conformed (Romans 8:29). While Caesar has the right to demand the money that bears his image, only the God whose image we are has the right to command the allegiance of our hearts. What are some of the ways in which we might be tempted to justify giving to Caesar what belongs only to God?

Examples: Setting our hope on the election of our preferred candidate rather than the return of our King; Trimming our consciences to avoid coming into conflict with the idolatrous demands of our culture, etc.



