Hallelujah! what a Savior!

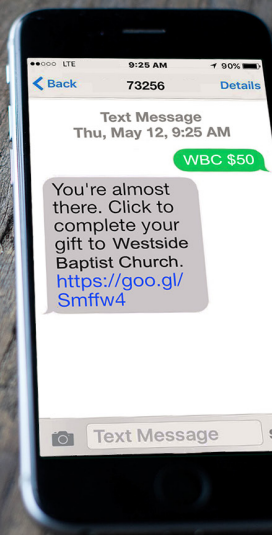
