Romans 1:1-1:32

Application Question (1:14):

We, like Paul, are “debtors,” under obligation to serve as ambassadors of the good news by which we have been redeemed. What are some of the reasons we might be tempted to ignore or postpone this obligation?

Examples: Fear of a negative response; a selfish busyness that is unwilling to make time for the needs of others; a failure to consider the reality of the judgment of God, etc.

Application Question (1:32):

Paul considered those who approve of sin to be as deserving of judgment as those who practice it. How might the entertainment choices that we make tempt us to give increasing approval to those who “commit such things?”


