



Romans 5

Application Question (5:10):

The Father sent his Son to die for us while we were still his enemies, sinners in active rebellion against him. What are some of the ways we might be tempted to justify disobedience to his command to show love to our own enemies (Matthew 5:44)?

Examples: Withdrawing from them so severely that we no longer have opportunity to love them; exaggerating their sin so as to justify our own; refusing to think of them as individuals at all; etc.

Application Question (5:12):

Because all have sinned, the sentence of eternal death has passed upon every human being. Apart from a living faith in Christ, there is no hope for anyone anywhere. How might we be tempted to ignore this sobering reality in our everyday life?

Examples: Being too "nice" to warn people about the coming judgment of God; becoming so consumed with our every-day business that we don't take time to think about the fate of the lost, etc.





For years, émigrés from the former Soviet bloc have been telling Rod Dreher they see telltale signs of "soft" totalitarianism cropping up in America. Identity politics are beginning to encroach on every aspect of life. Civil liberties are increasingly seen as a threat to "safety." Progressives marginalize conservative, traditional Christians, and other dissenters. Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn famously said that one of the biggest mistakes people make is assuming totalitarianism can't happen in their country.
