Romans 6

Application Question (6:1-2):

Paul makes it abundantly clear that all those who have truly received salvation from the judgment of God will war against the sins that deserve that judgment. How might we be tempted to forget this foundational gospel truth?

Examples: Believing that those who plainly have no interest in defeating sin have nevertheless escaped the judgment of God; Using God's promise of forgiveness as an excuse to tolerate sin in our lives instead of as a means of obliterating it, etc.

Application Question (6:16):

None of us are truly our own masters—all of us are serving someone all of the time. What are some of the ways in which pursuing "freedom" might lead us into bondage?

Examples: Young people imagining that escaping their parents' rules will bring "freedom"; Using the real danger of legalism as an excuse to abandon the pursuit of genuine holiness, etc.

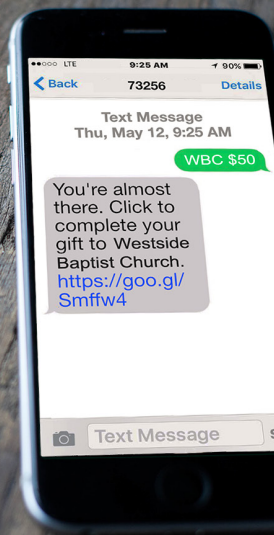

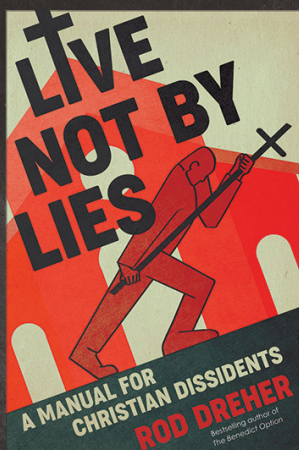

BOOK OF THE MONTH



For years, émigrés from the former Soviet bloc have been telling Rod Dreher they see telltale signs of “soft” totalitarianism cropping up in America. Identity politics are beginning to encroach on every aspect of life. Civil liberties are increasingly seen as a threat to “safety.” Progressives marginalize conservative, traditional Christians, and other dissenters. Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn famously said that one of the biggest mistakes people make is assuming totalitarianism can’t happen in their country. Many American Christians are making that mistake today, sleepwalking through the erosion of our freedoms. *Live Not By Lies* will wake them and equip them for the long resistance.
