Romans 7:1-8:17

Application Question (7:6-7:7, 8:3):

Righteousness is produced by the transformative power of the Spirit, not by the making and keeping of rules. How might we be tempted to forget this foundational principle?

Examples: Imagining that we can produce righteousness by inventing rules for ourselves and others; forgetting that the Spirit is given to lead us to *fulfill* righteousness, not to do away with the need for it, etc.

Application Question (8:14-15):

Though we were once God's enemies, we who belong to Christ have been adopted as his sons and daughters, made joint-heirs along with Jesus of the coming inheritance. What are some of the situations in which this should encourage us?

Examples: Rejection by our earthly families; financial setbacks, etc.

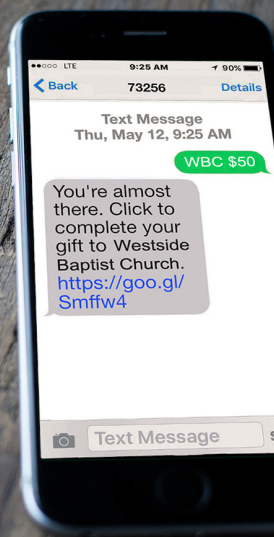

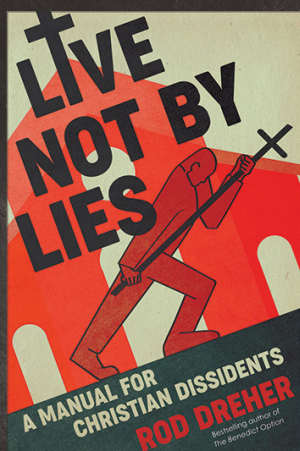

BOOK OF THE MONTH



For years, émigrés from the former Soviet bloc have been telling Rod Dreher they see telltale signs of “soft” totalitarianism cropping up in America. Identity politics are beginning to encroach on every aspect of life. Civil liberties are increasingly seen as a threat to “safety.” Progressives marginalize conservative, traditional Christians, and other dissenters. Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn famously said that one of the biggest mistakes people make is assuming totalitarianism can’t happen in their country. Many American Christians are making that mistake today, sleepwalking through the erosion of our freedoms. *Live Not By Lies* will wake them and equip them for the long resistance.
