Application Question (3:27):

For those who are justified by faith in the saving work of Jesus, human boasting of every kind has been altogether and forever excluded. What are some of things we might nevertheless be tempted to boast in?


Examples: How well we think we are doing at educating or training our children; how astute we think we are theologically; how far-sighted we are in our understanding of current events, etc.

Application Question (4:13):

As Paul makes clear, the promises God made to Abraham involved no less than the renewal of the whole world (see Romans 8!). How could we be encouraged by remembering just how big God's promises really are?

Examples: Understanding our present suffering in the light of the exceeding weight of glory that is coming; recognizing the eternal rewards of everyday faithfulness and the generational consequences of everyday unbelief, etc.

BOOK OF THE MONTH



For years, émigrés from the former Soviet bloc have been telling Rod Dreher they see telltale signs of "soft" totalitarianism cropping up in America. Identity politics are beginning to encroach on every aspect of life. Civil liberties are increasingly seen as a threat to "safety." Progressives marginalize conservative, traditional Christians, and other dissenters. Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn famously said that one of the biggest mistakes people make is assuming totalitarianism can't happen in their country. Many American Christians are making that mistake today, sleepwalking through the erosion of our freedoms. Live Not By Lies will wake them and equip them for the long resistance.


